School Uniform Information for the 2017-2018 School Year

Sweater	Navy, Royal or Light Blue; White, Black
Turtle Neck or Mock Turtle Neck	Navy, Royal or Light Blue; White, Black
Oxford Shirt / Blouse	Navy, Royal or Light Blue; White, Black
Polo Shirt	Navy, Royal or Light Blue; White, Black
Shorts	Navy Blue, Khaki, Black
Skorts	Navy Blue, Khaki, Black
Jumpers	Navy Blue, Khaki, Black
Slacks (capris are allowed)	Navy Blue, Khaki, Black

Tights	White, Navy, Black
Shoes	Low cut casual or dress shoe in brown or black. <u>Tennis shoes may be worn to school, but they must be primarily black in color.</u> No construction boots, no sandals or open back shoes. Students must have a separate pair of tennis shoes kept at school for use in the gym at recess or P.E.

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 All Students in 6th – 8th must have at least one “CLS polo”.

Additional Notes and Instructions

Shirts and Sweaters: **All shirts must have a collar**, must be buttoned, and tucked in. Colors allowed are black, white, and navy, royal or light blue. All shirts and sweaters must be a solid color. A “designer logo” is allowable as long as it is the size of a quarter or smaller. A Christ Lutheran fleece sweatshirt is available for purchase. No other sweatshirts are allowed.

Pants, Shorts, Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers and Slacks: Colors allowed are black, navy blue and khaki. The khaki color is to be “tan” – not olive or cream. Shorts are to be walking or dress shorts. No athletic shorts are allowed. **Pants are to be Docker or Bugle Boy type slacks or capris. No denim (jean) or corduroy materials are allowed. No yoga pants are allowed. Pants, capris and shorts may have only 4 "normal sized" pockets and must not have rivets or loops. Boys are to wear belts.** Shorts and skorts should have a minimum inseam length of 6 inches. Skirt length can be measured by having your daughter put her hands at her sides. If the skirt length is higher than her finger tips, it is too short. This is a minimum length and longer skirts are allowed.

Hair policy: The appropriateness of length, color and style will be at the discretion of the administration, faculty and school board. It is strongly recommended that before a significant change in a student’s hair is implemented, the student and parent review with the teacher and/or principal. Length: Students will be required to keep their hair neat and orderly. While a specific length will not be enforced, **shoulder length for boys and mid-back length for girls** are good guidelines. At no time shall the length and orderly make up of a child’s hair be allowed if it creates a disruption or safety issue. **No “extreme” styles will be allowed. For example, mohawks and liberty spikes will not be acceptable. Shaving images or words into the hair are not acceptable without prior review. Hair color should be limited to those “natural” colors such as black, brown, blonde and red.** Any consideration of a hair color that does not naturally occur should be reviewed. In some cases, the temporary hair colors may be allowed in support of special events (sports, play, etc.) but should have prior approval.

Other: There are to be no earrings for boys or excessive make-up or jewelry for girls. Tattoos are not allowed.

Dress Code Casual Days are scheduled for the 1st Friday of each month.
