Apparel Item Colors

Shoes Low cut casual or dress shoes or tennis shoes, but they should be primarily black. No construction boots, no sandals or open

back shoes. Students must have a separate pair of tennis shoes

kept at school for use in the gym at recess or P.E.

All Students in 6th – 8th must have at least one black polo for choir.

Additional Notes and Instructions

<u>Shirts and Sweaters</u>: **All shirts must have a collar**. Colors allowed are black, white, and navy, royal or light blue. All shirts and sweaters must be a solid color. A "designer logo" is allowable as long as it is the <u>size</u> of a quarter or smaller. Christ Lutheran sweatshirts are available for purchase. Plain sweatshirts (in school colors) with no writing are allowed.

<u>Pants, Shorts, Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers and Slacks</u>: Colors allowed are black, navy blue and khaki. The khaki color is to be "tan" – not olive or cream. Shorts are to be walking or dress shorts. No athletic shorts are allowed. **Pants are to be Docker type or capris. No denim (jean) or corduroy materials are allowed. No yoga pants are allowed. Pants, capris and shorts may have only 4 "normal sized" pockets and must <u>not</u> have rivets or loops. Pants and shorts must fit properly (not too big or too tight).** Shorts and skorts should have a <u>minimum</u> inseam length of 6 inches. Skirt length can be measured by having your daughter put her hands at her sides. If the skirt length is higher than her finger tips, it is too short. This is a minimum length and longer skirts are allowed.

Hair policy: The appropriateness of length, color and style will be at the discretion of the administration, faculty and school board. It is strongly recommended that before a significant change in a student's hair is implemented, the student and parent review with the teacher and/or principal. Length: Students will be required to keep their hair neat and orderly. At no time shall the length and orderly make up of a child's hair be allowed if it creates a disruption or safety issue. No "extreme" styles will be allowed. For example, mohawks and liberty spikes will not be acceptable. Shaving images or words into the hair are not acceptable without prior review. Hair color should be limited to those "natural" colors such as black, brown, blonde and red. Any consideration of a hair color that does not naturally occur should be reviewed. In some cases, the temporary hair colors may be allowed in support of special events (sports, play, etc.) but should have prior approval.

Other: There are to be no earrings or makeup for boys. Excessive or distracting make-up or jewelry for girls is not allowed. Tattoos are not allowed.

Dress Code Casual Days are scheduled for each Friday of the month.
